

PE Premium

- The school has received a £9,185 allocation of PE Premium. So far it has been used to:
- contribute to the costs of a specialist football, tennis dance and fitness teacher;
 - contribute to the training costs for Sports Leader to develop expertise, provision and effective partnerships with schools and organisations;
 - increase the range of sports on the curriculum and include new sports e.g. orienteering;
 - Provide targeted swimming provision for year 6 pupils in Summer 2014;
 - enable access and provision for sports led holiday provision and community use; e.g. Arsenal football holiday club, Tennis club and Active Spaces provision
 - add further top up to Pupil Premium funding to provide free places in Karate, Fencing and Breakfast club for vulnerable children;
 - increase in extra - curricular provision and the range of sporting activities available.
 - The continuing development of the sports pitch has enabled the school to increase provision to the school and wider community.

Impact so far...

- Over 200 children now attend extra-curricular clubs throughout the day and there has been a significant increase in parent participation through the success of the 'Tri -Fit Challenge', led by the fitness coach.
- All children will have the opportunity to take part in competitive sports within and beyond the school.
