Dear Parents/Carers

The time is drawing near for our exciting Year 6 trip to Paris from the 5th June to 8th June 2015! Below is some important information which we need to communicate to Parents/Carers, along with the confirmation of the departure and arrival times. Please kindly ensure this information is kept safe to help our Year 6 travellers prepare for this school journey.

Departure from School

Children will be travelling by coach from **Torriano Junior School** on **Friday 5th June 2015** to **St Pancras International Station**. Please ensure your child arrives at school for **6am** so that we can leave and arrive on time. The actual train departs at 8.31am but we have been given strict instructions to allow time to check in all the children.

Arrival from Paris

Children will arrive back at school at **5.30pm** on **Monday 8th June 2015**. Please can you ensure you are at school for this date and time to collect your child/children.

Please note: Children are not required to be in school on Tuesday 9th June or Wednesday 10th June so they can have 2 days of rest before returning back to school on Thursday 11th June 2015.

Bags and Luggage

Please note that children will be allowed to travel with one main case/bag which should be clearly labelled and a rucksack. The rucksack will also be required for use during the day outings.

Medical Needs

Children who need any medication (e.g. inhalers, epi-pens, tablets or creams) need to ensure they are handed to their class teacher clearly marked with name and class and in original packaging no later than **3.30pm** on **Tuesday 19th May 2015**.

Pocket Money

Your child is allowed to bring up to a maximum of 40 Euros for pocket money. This must be given to their class teacher by **3.30pm on Tuesday 19th May 2015**, in an envelope clearly marked with their name and amount enclosed. It would be ideal if Parents/Carers can ensure the amount of pocket money is easily divided by 4. For example, if you wish to give your child 20 Euros, please hand in of 4 x 5 Euro notes so that a daily allowance of 5 Euros can be handed out each day.

Clothing

We suggest that children bring clothing for a variety of practical activities. Jeans and jogging bottoms are advisable as they are warm, comfortable and practical. **School T-Shirts** will be available to purchase from the school office from **3.30pm on Friday 15th May 2015** and cost £5.00.
