12th December: Anxiety

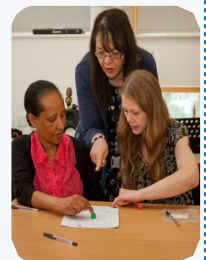
Parent Academy - You Can Still Join!
