

Who Do I Want To Be?



Curriculum Information Summer 2019

This half term our learning will be focused around 'The Jolly Postman'. We will be working in collaboration with The Postal Museum to provide a meaningful learning experience where the children will get first hand experience of the postal system. As part of this topic we will also be exploring a range of traditional tales. After half term we will be taking part in the whole-school project about the life and works of Leonardo Da Vinci. Finally, we will end the term by learning about the food from around the world in preparation for the EYFS International Festival, to which you are all welcome!

Understanding of the World

We will be looking at the life and works of Leonardo Da Vinci, using this to inspire us to become inventors, artists and mathematicians. The children will be learning about different countries and their cultures. We will be celebrating where we are from and why we are unique. The children will also be learning how to cook food from different cultures.

Literacy



This term the children will be familiarising themselves with different traditional tales. They will be describing characters and events from a selection of stories from 'The Jolly Postman' book. We will be reading lots of poems and stories from around the world - feel free to come and read a traditional story from your country! We will be exploring sounds as a tool for reading and writing names and labels.

Maths



We will be looking at different sizes and weights and measuring ingredients as we prepare food for the festival. We will be counting pennies when buying and selling food. In our role play we will be counting letters and looking for numbers on houses to deliver them to. We will be learning to write numbers on our letters and parcels. We will be continuing to order and write numerals.

Physical Development



This term we will be practising for Sports Day. The children will also be learning different movements to music from around the world. They will continue to develop their gross and fine motor skills and use equipment and the environment safely through play and exploration.



Expressive Arts and Design



This term Tom Cambata will be teaching the children songs from different cultures that we are planning to perform at our International Festival. As part of the whole-school project, we will explore the works of Leonardo Da Vinci. We will continue to paint, print, draw and sculpt models using various media, tools and materials.

Communication and Language



This term Nursery will be exploring both traditional tales and stories from around the world. As part of our learning the children will be taking on different roles and acting out traditional tales. We will continue to develop our oracy skills in different contexts.

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

We will be continuing to learn how to be a good friend and help others through circle time games, class discussions and stories. The children will be learning how to identify how they feel and how feelings can change over time. As part of being a Healthy School we will be working with the children to identify healthy foods and how to take care of ourselves through what we do and eat. We will be encouraging children to talk about how we feel and how to adapt to change and manage our own behaviour appropriately. We will be preparing children for the next stage in their school journey, when they will be moving to Reception and making new friends.
