Who do I want to be?

Next term, as part of our STEAM project, we will be learning all about wonderful weather, linked to the seasons. Over the Easter holidays, we would like you to begin to immerse yourself in this topic in a fun and creative way. This means experiments, art, making and exploration! We would like you to have a go at one or some of the following;

- Create your own weather tools (weather vane to check the wind direction, rain gauge to see how much rain has fallen).
 - Observe and record what the weather is like in the season of spring,
- Observe and record the length of the days - what time does the sun rise and set? (You can use BBC weather to help you find this information.)

How to record your project

You could use the google slides in our classroom to record what you make in project or you could use your home learning journal. Pictures, photographs and videos are always welcome! You could create a poster or page explaining how you made or designed your weather tools and how it works.
